Many of you may know that we have been running a location in the town of Milliken for the past 4 years. We have been leasing our space there and attempting to negotiate buying the building. However, over the last year, those negotiations have become tenuous and in the last month have become untenable. Our lease of that space will be ending August 15th.

This will not affect our programming here, but we had been waiting on doing some hiring because we wanted to be sure all teachers could keep their jobs. Due to some widespread community support, the landlord in Milliken has agreed to allow another entity to take over the child care center there, so at this point it appears they will maintain all of their staff. You have seen some substitutes and “working interviews” in the classroom and we are putting together a dynamite team! We adore the teachers coming in and know you will too. With 11 classrooms all together, we often have one or another that is experiencing some rearranging. However, once we get good teacher teams, they stick around for YEARS. The Eagle Room had the same 2 teacher team for 6 years, the Penguin Classroom had been under Corinne’s charge for 4 years before she moved rooms and the Parrot Room, before we were working on the current team, had been with Ms. Rachel for 4 years before that. Creating these teams takes a great deal of watching, listening and training, but is worth it in the end.

We appreciate your patience as we get these few spots stable and all teachers “Young Peoples” trained.

In addition, we ask for your patience this week in particular as we have SEVEN Young Peoples staff members on vacation this week. We have some amazing subs and won’t have anyone here who we don’t already know, but things will look a little bit different for the week.
